FEATURE ARTICLE

THE GOD OF DIVINE ENCOUNTER ON THE MISSION FIELD. GENESIS 12:1-3

As always, the interpretation of the Mission field to so many people is different. The most interesting one, is that some in the mission group believe that the food or drink or rest they didn't experience in

their home for some time, it is when they go out there, these things should be enjoyed and relished. In other words, mission is excursion time. Have you experienced this interpretation in your walk or working with God?

When the Lord gave the general theme of "**Walking and Working with GOD**" to us, for **OOA FOUNDATION** it was clear that we were going to be confronted with these setting. Therefore, this feature article brings to your door step the core disposition of all who will relate with **OOA FOUNDATION** this year and beyond.

WHAT IS DIVINE ENCOUNTER

Divine encounter implies that a man experiences the power of the Almighty suddenly. In Acts 16:25-26, the bible says, 'And suddenly there was a great earthquake...' Paul and Silas never expected that they would encounter any experience in their missionary journey. Look at some of these bible experiences and draw strength from them.

- **Genesis 12:1-3:** God calls Abraham, promising to make him a great nation and bless the world through him.
- **Exodus 3:2-6:** Moses encounters God in the burning bush, revealing His name and commissioning him to free Israel.
- **Isaiah 6:1-8:** Isaiah sees the Lord in the temple, leading to his cleansing and prophetic calling ("Here am I. Send me!").
- **Genesis 16:10:** The Angel of the Lord appears to Hagar, promising to multiply her descendants.

In the New Testament we see the following examples of divine encounter.

- **Luke 1:28:** The Angel Gabriel greets Mary, announcing her favor and the Lord's presence.
- **Acts 2:2-4:** The Holy Spirit descends as tongues of fire at Pentecost, empowering the disciples.
- **Acts 9:3-6:** Saul's dramatic encounter with the risen Christ on the road to Damascus leads to his conversion.
- **John 1:14:** "The Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory" (Jesus as the ultimate encounter).

PROPELLED DIVINE ENCOUNTER

People of faith must, as a matter of necessity must have a propelling force that can move and take them away from point A to B, positively. In doing this, strength must be gathered. That's why the experience of prophet Jeremiah should serve as an enabling example for us.

Jeremiah 33:3 is a promise from God that encourages prayer, saying, "Call to me, and I will answer you, and will tell you great and hidden things that you have not known," with variations in

wording like "marvelous and wondrous things" or "mighty things". It's a message of hope and intimacy, assuring people that God is accessible and ready to reveal profound truths and solutions to those who genuinely call out to Him in prayer, even during times of hardship, promising guidance beyond human understanding. This, thus represent the propelling strength to move on.

What we must understand about Divine Encounter

• **Invitation to Prayer:**

God invites His people to call out to Him, emphasizing His constant availability.

• **Divine Revelation:**

He promises to share "great and hidden things" or "marvelous and wondrous things," meaning deep spiritual truths, future plans, and solutions to problems beyond human comprehension.

• **Hope in Despair:**

In its original context, this promise offered hope to the people of Judah facing destruction, assuring them of restoration and blessings after judgment.

• **Relationship, Not Just Ritual:**

The verse highlights prayer as a real, relational part of a relationship with God, not just empty words.

Typical example of an encounter with God in the Bible?

One day, while Moses was caring for the flock, he encountered the burning bush—a supernatural manifestation that marked the beginning of his call to lead the Israelites out of bondage. Through this encounter, God transformed Moses' life, revealing His name (Yahweh) and His plan to deliver Israel. If we cannot go through this process it might be difficult to understand and even experience a divine encounter on the mission field.

Essential Meanings and Significance of divine encounter:

Invitation to Prayer:

God actively invites people to call out to Him. Promise of Answer: He promises to listen and respond personally.

Divine Revelation: He offers to show "great and mighty/unsearchable things," revealing spiritual truths and future purposes hidden from human knowledge.

Hope in Crisis: In Jeremiah 33:3 we see hope to Jeremiah during his imprisonment, showing God's willingness to work and reveal purpose even in despair.

Therefore, for the purposes of a **Divine Encounter** on the mission field this experience of Jeremiah makes it a cornerstone verse which encourages a deep, prayerful relationship with God for guidance, wisdom, and revelation. As you proceed on the mission field, desire to experience A **DIVINE ENCOUNTER** for a fulfilled life in Christ Jesus.

ALSO, OOA FOUNDATION WAS ABLE TO MAKE A DONATION TO ONE OF THE MOST FOREMOST PRIVATE HOSPITALS IN KADUNA TOWN. IN ADDITION, TOKEN DONATIONS TO SOME CHURCHES AND INDIVIDUAL IN THE CURSE OF THE YEAR WERE MADE. WE SINCERELY THANK GOD FOR HIS GRACE AND ENABLEMENT.

OUR MAJOR FOCUS IS UNCHANGED BUT OUR EXPANSION HAS BEEN GUARANTEED.

NEWSFROM CORE FOCUS

MOVING MISSION FOCUS (MMF)

MMF has continually maintained it's regular service position by providing the daily devotionals and offering counselling sessions to deserving persons when they show up. It will continue and with more vigor in 2026. However, manpower is militating against its function but with Divine Encounter this will be overcome.

AGRICULTURAL MISSION FOCUS (AMF).

AMF has been improving from year to year. In the year 2025 it experimented with dry season farming with a great success which culminating into three maize cropping pattern last year. This year 2026, dry season irrigation farming has commenced with maize. New maize seed variety from the Institute of Agricultural Research (IAR) Ahmadu Bello University Zaria is being tested. The all year round stream has been a great asset not minding the environmental pollution, we are able to do minor purifications before use.

Good yield in sweet potato cropping was experienced last year which will last till February on the field before final harvesting. Other crop yields include tomatoes, Palm kernel, bananas, mangoes, lemon, and cashew to mention a few. Avogadro pear from the eastern part of Nigeria was introduced as a seed and they are now up ready for maturation.

EDUCATIONAL MISSION FOCUS (EMF)

Two students who currently enjoy scholarships from OOAFAF are said to be making substantial progress;

this is based on the information from the school. The tuition fee is being paid as at when due. There was an increase in fees by the management of the school and this has been handled.

Just for mentioning under EMF. The President of OOA FOUNDATION instituted academic prizes in two Nigerian Universities in the past year. The Universities are Ahmadu Bello University Zaria and The Federal University of Technology, Minna.

At Ahmadu Bello University Zaria the prizes were instituted in The Department of Physiology, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine. They are for the following students:

1. Best graduating student in Veterinary Physiology in the penultimate year.

2. Best graduating student in reproductive physiology with the minimum grade of B This will be the first ever prize award for the Department of Physiology students since the inception of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Ahmadu Bello University Zaria.. The prize award is five hundred thousand naira only per student per award for the next ten years. The total sum for this year has been paid.

At the Federal University of Technology, Minna the prize ward is for the best graduating student in Reproductive Physiology. The award is worth fifty thousand naira per student per award for the next ten years. The total sum of award for the ten years has been paid to the University.

CORE DEPARTMENTS IN OOAF

They include the following:

1. **Moving Mission Focus (MMF).** This section deals with the daily devotionals and mission training exercises of the agency. It has just one staff helping to

coordinate most of the efforts for now. It actual was the foundation unit of OOAF – hence most of our previous documents bear MMF

2. **Scientific Mission Focus (SMF).** This section deals squarely with our major research concepts which equally give us outreach opportunity to other scientific trainings. It has a building currently being equipped with scientific equipments to help our day to day activity. It has a bearing support to all departments.
3. **Agricultural Mission Focus. (AMF).** Here we engage in our field work with agricultural production. Currently we are managing a little 5 hectares of land where we grow and hope to expand. Here we train people and offer field and tailored training to interested people at their location. Essentially, extensive missionary work is equally done here.
4. **Educational Mission Focus (EMF).** This handles all our scholarship training scheme and advice to prospective persons who desire to obtain sound education. This is inclusive of theological training as well as conventional and technological training establishments.
5. **Artificial Intelligent Focus (AiMF).** This is the newest unit being established. The major essence is the use of Artificial Intelligent training to effectively achieve mission work and coordinate the loose ends of our other departments.
6. **Children Mission Focus (CMF).** This unit is expected to focus on interaction and rehabilitation of children around the environment of the FOUNDATION.
7. **Production Media Focus (PMF).** Responsible for publications and information unit of the agency.

Be assured that as the Lord taries and gives more grace, the agency will expand more than the current units.


